2021 Slate Cabernet Sauvignon High Valley, Lake County

Tasting Notes:

The 2021 Cabernet is a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon grown in the Red Hills AVA of Lake County, immediately to the east of the Napa Valley. Dense, dark and exotic, the aromatics reveal tobacco leaf, cocoa and blackberry. Supple, rich tannins coat the mouth with the seamless finish.

Winemaking:

Grapes were harvested in the early morning to ensure the fruit's cool temperature. We cold soak the berries to draw color and develop flavors while elevating structure. Aged in 30% new French oak barrels with 100% native yeast fermentation.
