2021 Slate Rosé Santa Barbara County

Tasting Notes:

Pale salmon pink in color, the wine is lifted in its aromas of guava and blood orange with notes of sage and lavender. Plush and broad in the mouth, the wine finishes with bright acidity and a mouthwatering freshness.

Winemaking:

From the cool and fog-filled western hills of the Santa Maria Valley, this wine shows rhubarb and strawberry aromatics balanced by expressive minerality and precise acidity. Picked expressly to produce rosé, the grapes were hand-harvested at night to preserve the coolness and whole-cluster pressed to retain its vibrancy.
